## PARENTING Prompts

Every child
is different and in a
different place in

Please use these
ideas as appropriate
for you, your child
and your family.

ELEMENTARY

Stand with your child in front of a mirror.

Tell them what you see - starting with physical attributes then moving to what you see in their character and personality.

Call out the things you see and admire about their character, their heart and their potential.

Play a worship song that reminds you of who God is and of His love for you.

Dance and since along with your child.

Play the song throughout this week to remind you and your child of God's love.

When we pause and look at our kids in the eyes for an extended period of time, and we listen to them and speak loving and affirming words, they feel seen - like someone understands them and is listening to them in a very real way. When your kid walks into the room, stop what you are doing, look at them, and let them know you are happy to see them.

Set aside time to spend with just your child.

Let them know you would like to spend time together doing their favorite thing.

Ask them what they want to do together and
talk about what they like about that activity.

As you spend time together, tell them

"I am so happy to be with you, and God loves to be with us too!"
